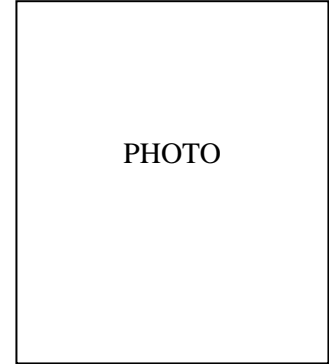

The applicants are requested to kindly go through the following instructions, prescribed qualifications and experience for each post before filling up of the application

1. The details of academic positions for which applications are invited together with age, educational qualification, experience required are detailed in Annexure "A" to this notification.
2. The qualification, experience, age etc. shall be reckoned as on last date for submission of application (which shall be one month from the date of notification of the advertisement).
3. The age limit shall be relaxed by 5 years for SC / ST and by 3 years for OBC/ PwDs / Ex-Servicemen.
4. The candidates selected shall be on probation for a period of two years from the date of appointment.
5. The selected candidates will be governed by New Pension Scheme and Retirement / Terminal benefits for all the posts shall be as per Government of India norms.
